Begin a career in hairdressing as an adult learner by studying this part-time course. Learn the essential skills required to work in the fast-paced, fashion conscious hairdressing industry including shampooing and conditioning, styling hair and cutting OR colouring.

It is offered on a part-time basis subject to age, experience and motivation, and includes training in the following: working in the hair industry, health & safety, shampooing and conditioning, styling hair and cutting OR colouring.

Entry Requirements:

Applicants will need to demonstrate a keen interest in hairdressing and enjoy working as part of a team. This course is open to any individual wishing to progress their career in hairdressing.

Assessment Information:

You are continually assessed throughout the course working on clients and there will be some online tests to cover the theory aspects of the course.
