Course Overview:

Take the first steps into the world of leadership and management with this introductory short course for adult learners. You will explore the key principles of effective leadership and develop practical skills to manage teams confidently. The course covers communication, motivation, problem-solving, and decision-making, helping learners build the confidence to lead with purpose and support their team's success. Ideal for anyone looking to take their first steps into management.

What's Covered:

During this 20-hour course you will develop essential knowledge and skills needed for effective first-line management. The course will cover:

- The role and responsibilities of a first-line manager
- Key leadership styles and how to apply them
- Effective communication and active listening skills
- Motivating and supporting team members
- Delegation and task management
- Problem-solving and decision-making in a managerial role
- Managing performance and providing constructive feedback
- Building confidence and professionalism as a leader

By the end of the course, learners will have the skills and confidence to step into a first line management role and lead their team successfully.

Entry Requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for this course. It is suitable for aspiring first-line managers or those new to a supervisory role. Learners should have a willingness to develop leadership skills and an interest in managing and supporting a team effectively.

Assessment Information:

There are no formal assessments, just supportive learning and activities in class. You will work through an individual learning plan and receive regular feedback from your tutor.

This course is FREE to adult learners aged 19+.

- Join our TQUK level 2 Certificate in Principles of Team Leading course to help you pursue your future career
