Our Level 3 T-Level in Education & Early Years will give you the foundation you need to set you on the path towards your ideal career.

Focusing on working with children aged 0-19, the T-Level qualification combines learning in the classroom with gaining vital 'on-the-job' experience.

In year one, you will gain core knowledge of subjects such as supporting education, health and wellbeing, safeguarding and Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND), as well as developing a range of technical and practical skills that employers are looking for.

The

Early Years pathway

focuses on working with children from birth to 5 years old in nurseries, preschools and reception classes. You will learn how to support young children's growth and development, plan educational activities, and meet their physical, emotional, and social needs. This pathway prepares you for roles within early years, gaining a license to practice and can provide a stepping stone to becoming a Primary School Teacher.

Entry Requirements:

You'll need a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including maths and English Language and in subjects that are relevant to the course you'd like to study.

Assessment Information:

You will be assessed through written and practical examinations, employer projects, group work, presentations and analysis. You will also be observed and assessed in the workplace.
