## What's Covered:

## Entry Requirements:

Five GCSEs at grade 5 or above, including English, Maths and Science.

## Assessment Information:

The core knowledge and understanding will be assessed through an examination and core skills through a practical employer-set project.

The occupational specialism in the second year will provide an opportunity to pursue either of the following routes

- Legal Services Assistant - business, finance and employment
- Legal Services Assistant - crime, criminal justice and social welfare
